CHAMPAGNE *Our Champagne is served in 175ml measures*

NV Brut Grande Reserve Premier Cru, Gobillard, Champagne, France

This cuvee is made with Premier Cru grapes mainly from the commune of Hautvillers (where the monk, Dom Perignon pioneered the production of Champagne), but with some blending with premier crus in Cumieres and Dizy. This is an elegant Champagne with a bouquet of citrus blossom that precedes a delicate array of greengages and honey on the tongue.

The vibrant palate is deliciously crisp, juicy and textured, layered with mineral notes through to a refreshing, zesty finish. A recognised gooseberry palate, as you would expect, however this is far more refined than some of intense 'slap round the face' New Zealand' sauvignons and offers far more balance.

A youthful fresh wine with quince and pear drops flavours. Earlier picked freshness shows on the palate with green apple and grapefruit, for the £34 this is an exceptional mouth-watering wine.				
Albarino, Coral Do Mar, Rias Baixas, Spain				£35.00
This wine has lovely fresh flavours of orange zest and peach, with hints of saline. It has a beautiful rich mouth feel. A classic spicy Albarino, enjoy with seafood or fish dishes. Once described as a Sauvignon Blanc that's "not trying too hard."				
Roussane, Muscat D'Alexandre, En Passant Blanc, Gayda, Languedoc, France				£35.00
Peach and baked apple flavours, a creamy texture, and some floral characteristics from the Muscat. Very much a food wine, with its oily texture and bitter notes this would stand up really well to roasted white meats.				
Bacchus, Flint Vineyard, Earsham, Norfolk				£38.00
This is a lovely alternative to a New Zealand Sauvignon, but the gooseberry is a little more refined. Its bright, fresh, with aromas of elderflower. It's crisp but not too acidic and has a lovely balance of sweetness. It's great with seafood and even recommended with fish & chips, for the adventurous patron. In our opinion its Flint Vineyards' best vintage on their Bacchus.				
Bacchus Reserve, Burn Valley, N.Creake, Norfolk £39.50				
A local vineyard's take on one of England's favourite varieties. This wine is slightly more rounded, and less gooseberry driven than Flint's. Soft on the palate with strong tropical fruits like pineapple, along with elderflower and delicate lemon. Aged in Hungarian oak, this gives it a better approach to food.				
Chenin Blanc, THE LARK, Olifantsberg, Breedekloof, South Africa				£42.00
This single estate Chenin Blanc was awarded 93 points by Tim Atkin and in our opinion could easily be mistaken as a white burgundy. It is refined, elegant and fresh. This wine has great length and can stand up well to a variation of our smokey fish and seafood dishes.				
Sauvignon Blanc, Saint Clair, Marlborough, New Zealand				£43.00
Saint Clair has a worldwide reputation for top quality wines. A concentrated, punchy Sauvignon Blanc with intense guava and lemon fruit with creamy viscosity and freshness. A classic but classy wine with good weight and a lingering finish – If you love Cloudy Bay, you will love this sauvignon.				
Chardonnay, Macon-Villages, Burgundy, France				£44.00
Olivier Ravier, one of the most iconic winemakers in Beaujolais, tries his hand at a Macon. This wine is deep golden in colour with delicious notes of white fruits and citrus. Textured on the palate with an appealing roundness and a refreshing lift to the finish.				
Pinot Grigio Mongris, Marco Felluga, Friuli-Venezia Giulia				£45.00
This is a truly class pinot grigio, golden yellow in colour, it has an intense and immediate bouquet with pronounced hints of acacia flowers and apple. To taste, it is elegantly fruity and feels almost full bodied. It is well structured and stands its own against the light, mass produced Italian Pinot Grigios that have flooded the wine industry. Sancerre, Domaine Noel et Jean-Luc Raimbault, Loire, France				£45.00
This refreshing wine has a lovely balance of acidity and purity of fruit, with citrus and stone fruits complemented by a touch of minerality. The grapes are pulled from gnarled vines that sit on the upper reaches of the Sury vineyard slopes, it is a jewel of Sancerre that delivers pure Sauvignon Blanc.				
Pouilly-Fuisse, Nadine Ferrand, Burgundy France				£59.00
Our Executive Head Chef said he would drink this all day long, it's superb! An elegant Pouilly-Fuisse, straw coloured, showing aromas of peach, and citrus. A rich, complex, and well-balanced wine with remarkable vivacity on the finish. This chardonnay is truly outstanding.				
Chateaufeuf-du-Pape BLANC, Domaine Chante Cigale				£63.00
Made with Clairette grapes, its hauntingly fragrant, reminiscent of almond and peach blossom. The palate is a wonderfully smooth, silky expression of dried apricots, baked cooking apple, with a clean saline finish. It's not often we see a white Chateaufeuf-du-Pape but we were very impressed.

One of our teams' favourites. An aromatic Sicilian red packed with red berries, Mediterranean herbs, and a light dusting of black pepper. This is perfect match to anything with sweet tomato. If you like your red slightly chilled this wine is happy to oblige.				
Malbec, Merlot, Chateau Vincens, Cahors, Southwest France				£35.00
Although Argentina made malbec famous, France was the original home of Malbec. Medium crimson-ruby in colour. Aromas of smoky blackberries with good acidity running through. This is a great malbec and worth every penny.				
Montepulciano, Nero d'Avlo, Wild & Wilder, Cloud Cuckooland, Riverland, Australia				£36.00
This wine is so versatile. It could be served chilled to complement a mild autumn evening, or served at room temperature. Dark plum & cherry flavours with an almost cocoa mouthfeel. For the vegetarians, it's a great wine to have with a savoury tart-tatin or anything with a sweet tomato element. Or for the carnivores, we recommend trying some local game: pigeon or deer, anyone?				
Cabernet Sauvignon, Grower's Touch, New South Wales, Australia				£40.00
Let's bring out the big guns here. This wine brings a right hook to the nose with aromas of ripe cassis, blackberry, and a bit of clove. On the palate, you get what you expect with strong flavours of rich plum, blackcurrant, and vanilla AND chocolate on the finish. A wine that practically demands a nice juicy steak. At 14%, this Cabernet is everything you could ask for.				
Syrah Crozes-Hermitage, Domaine Des Hautes Chassis, Esquisse, Northern Rhone, France				£40.00
A fantastic Syrah from Northern Rhone. This is a big, spicy, expressive, juicy, and fresh wine from a biodynamic vineyard. A classic French Rhone.				
Fleurie, Beaujolais, Burgundy, France				£41.00
Contrasting the typical style of a classic Beaujolais, this Fleurie stands out against the crowd. A gorgeous full wine hailing in at 14.5% ABV to ensure a good time. Filled with aromas of blueberries and fresh earth, the palate takes a sharp turn. Cranberry, raspberry, and thyme flush the finish.

Steeped in history dating back to 1692, the Lanzerac wine estate, home to the first bottled Pinotage, is situated at the foot of Jonkershoek valley. Masses of black fruit, currants, and berries, this wine is luscious with soft tannins to round it out.			
Chianti, Villa Saletta, Tuscany, Italy			£45.00
This wine is deep red in colour. On the nose it has an elegant aroma of red fruits, black cherries, spices and a hint of floral perfumes. Taste, it has flavours of black fruits and is powerful with juicy tannins that guide the mouth to a smooth texture.			
Zinfandel, Bogle, California, USA			£46.00
A personal favourite of the GM. This wine's nose is filled with damp damson, muted blackberries, and charred oak. The palate is equipped with explosive flavours of intense juicy plum, ripe blueberries, and a long burnt toffee and cedar finish. When you're hunkering down for the winter, make sure you're stocked up on this wine. Definitely one to share amongst good company.			
Malbec, Susana Balbo Mendoza, Argentina			£47.00
Female wine maker Susana Balbao is Argentina's first female oenologist and owner of her own eponymous winery. Elegance and power in a glass. Intensely coloured with great concentration of flavour which has been created mainly by two cabernets (Sauvignon and Franc). Its smooth and delicious. Girl power!			
Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Southern Rhône, France			£49.00
A stunning example of what this well-known region does so well – red fruits, cranberries, lavender, thyme, and rosemary on the nose. Elegant and silky with ripe tannins with cassis and herb character to finish. Jammy black fruits. Lushly rich and powerful. The perfect Sunday lunch wine.			
Amarone della Valpolicella, Cantina Di Negrar, Veneto, Italy			£52.00
Grapes dried with the classic Appassimento technique, this wine is deep and intense in colour with black cherries and plums on the nose. The rich velvety tannins accompanied with subtle flavours of raisin and spice structure the backbone of this Amarone. It's truly an indulgent wine.			
Gran Reserva Rioja, Bodegas Olarra, Cerro Anon, Spain			£55.00
A gorgeous Gran Rioja true to its style. Soft fruits of black cherry and blueberry, along with fresh pipe-tobacco deliver this gorgeous warm and inviting bouquet. Delicate tannins partner with non-threatening blueberry bushes and a wonderfully oaked herbal thyme finish. Quite possibly the most refined and well-balanced wine our list.

ABLEFORTH'S RUMBULLION £5.95

A spiced rum made using Caribbean rum, Madagascan vanilla, orange peel, cinnamon, clove and cardamon, rich and intense.

ANGOSTURA 7-YEAR-OLD RUM £5.95

A voluptuous blend of molasses-based, continuous distilled rums aged in charred American oak barrels for seven years.

APPLETON ESTATE RESERVE BLEND £5.95

A sweet smooth sipper with an 8-year-old heritage.

APPLETON ESTATE 12-YEAR-OLD RARE BLEND £6.60
