Cremant de Loire Brut, De Chanceny

A bit richer and more rounded than a Prosecco and as close to Champagne as you can get without the name, or indeed the price. A lot of work and commitment goes into making this delicious wine, hand picking, gentle pressing and cool fermentation ensure all the aromas are preserved. It then takes on a second fermentation in the bottle. The bottles are stored horizontally on wooden laths for a minimum of 18 months. The bubbles are fine, the flavours are biscuity and smooth a wonderful sparkling.

San Marzano, 'Liboll' Primitivo Spumante Rose, Extra Dry, Puglia, Italy

A refreshing and crisp sparkling Rose, with a pale salmon hue, fin mousse and aromatic notes of cherry blossom, pink grapefruit and pomegranate. This is a wonderful sunshine wine.

Charmat Rosé, Flint Vineyards, Norfolk, England

Autreau Roualet Brut NV, Champagne, France

Family run since 1670 in the Premier Cru village of Champillon, just north of Epernay. This Champagne has delicate bubbles ensuring you can taste its nutty and biscuity flavours. A fantastic Champagne by the glass with a moreish temptation to order a bottle.

Veuve Clicquot, Brut Yellow Label, Champagne, France

£95.00

Veuve Clicquot's signature Yellow Label needs no introduction on its quality and style. Its brilliant yellow label reflects the champagnes bright personality and impeccable credentials. Predominately made from Pinot Noir providing the structure Chardonnay is added to offer the finesse and to perfectly add balance. A fine mousse and silkiness from the three-year ageing in Crayeres. A wonderful aroma with the recognised Veuve palate of apple and pears with vanilla and tasty brioche from the oak ageing.

Laurent Perrier Cuvee Rose, NV, Champagne, France

This exceptional Champagne is almost too well known, a world-famous pink Champagne in its iconic bottle, it is beautifully refined with layers of red berry. Made with 100% Pinot Noir grapes, its lively well rounded and very special. An obvious choice by Champagne connoisseurs.

Billecart Salmon Rose, Champagne, France

£128.00

Pale pink in colour with golden hints and fine delicate bubbles, leading to a beautiful mousse. The bouquet is fine and elegant with ripe strawberries and raspberries. To taste, this is refined with prominent fruit flavours. Our sommeliers personal favourite Rose Champagne.

Billecart Blanc de Blanc, Champagne, France

£128.00

Unlike most champagne this sparkling is made of 100% white grapes, wine connoisseurs know Blanc de Blanc as the epitome of finesse and elegance. We were super impressed with this Billecart Salmon Blanc de Blanc, its mouthfeel is almost creamy and buttery with fine bubbles allowing the appreciation of the texture, buttery brioche and nutty characters to be appreciated. We absolutely love this Champagne and it was the winner, for us, when tasting Billecart Salmons full range.

Piper Heidsieck, Rare, Millesime 2008, Champagne, France

£265.00

This limited Champagne is subject to availability, its literally 'rare' this year. Multi award winning this Champagne is crystal-clear, light gold in colour. The initial nose shines with the pure vivacity of this vintage, showing pronounced aromas of orange blossom, hyacinth and white flowers, with notes of just-ripe William's pear, fresh coconut, almond, and tangerine. The palate is crisp and precise, with citrus and tropical fruit lingering on the long, complex finish - the presentation is as beautiful as the taste. Stunning! You will definitely want to hang on to the bottle making it a great celebration champagne with a stunning bottle as a keep sake.

Louis Roederer Cristal Brut, Louis Roederer, Champagne, France

The most luxurious of Champagnes. Only produced in the greatest of vintages. This wine has hints of citrus and candied apricots. On the palate a toasted nuttiness combines with seductive hints of vanilla. A Champagne that rises to the occasion Cristal is a very special treat.

Sauvignon, Terre du Soleil, Pays d'Oc, France

A zesty Sauvignon Blanc from South of France, refreshing with flavours of grapefruit, pear and lemon combined with mineral notes and a lovely consistent, flavourful finish. Deliciously drinkable.

Pinot Grigio, Umbrele, Banat Region, Romania

Lovely opulent aromas of peach, melon, and apple, this has delicious citrusy flavours and offer so much more fun and flavour than some big-name Italian Pinot Grigios.

Falanghina and Chardonnay, Tenimento Grieco Anima Osca Bianco, Italy

£29.00

A deliciously refreshing blend from the coast of Italy, with elegant fruity and floral notes leading to a crisp palate, with a slight saltiness this wine is perfect with oysters. Falanghina is a great alternative to pinot grigio and with the touch of chardonnay these is a certain refined roundness to this wine, Outstanding value for money.

Muscadet Sevre-et-Maine sur Lie, Chateau du Poyet. Loire, France

£30.00

Early picking of the grapes, sometimes before full ripening helps to attain a good fresh acidity. To preserve maximum freshness the wine is bottled at the Chateau straight from the vat off its lees (Sur Lie) without any racking. This wine is a pale, tangy, crisp wine from the Western end of the Loire River, delivers enhanced mouthfeel and flavour by additional lees contact: this is the time spent on the particles left after fermentation, which gives texture and complexity to this light, quaffable wine style. This wine is perfect with uncomplicated seafood dishes like natural oysters, mussels and crab.

White Rioja, Lopez de Haro, Spain

£32.00

Fresh with notes of citrus, pear and tropical fruits that mingle with richer notes of oak characters of spicy toastiness and butter notes on the finish. An interesting and complex wine that over delivers every time.

PicquePoul Terret, Cotes de Thau, L'arete De Thau, Languedoc-Roussillon, France

£5.35 £8.00 £10.50 £32.00

This is a wonderful, light Picquepol with a lively palate of grapefruit and citrus. It's a perfectly versatile wine with so many of our dishes especially our local shellfish. Value for money this is remarkable.

Grenache Blanc, Felicette, Languedoc Roussillon, France

£34.00

In homage to Felicette, the first cat to travel to space in 1963! This is a super alternative to Sauvignon Blanc. An intense but fresh aroma combining mint, pear, dry apricot, and white flowers. Wonderfully fresh to taste with flavours of mango and a hint of a spice leading into a crispy lime zest finish. This is a great food wine.

Gavi DOCG, Volpi. Piedmonte, Italy

£6.00 £8.50 £12.00 £33.00

A stunning example of a Gavi made from 100% Cortese grapes. This fragrant and fresh wine, taste is reminiscent of a northern Italian meadow: wild flowers, leaves, grass and citrus... stunningly moreish and totally dreamy. This wine loves a relationship with seafood, fish and chicken and happy to hold its own with a touch of cream and even goats cheese.

Grüner Veltliner, Funkstille, Niederosterreich, Austria

£6.15 £9.25 £12.30 £35.00

Subtle exotic fruits, ripe melon, pear, & fresh citrus. This wine is dry with great complex flavours and a soft mouthfeel. The palate is rich but refreshing. One of the most underrated on our list once you have one glass it could be your go to glass. This is so delicious with our dishes that have spot of spice and curry flavours, one of our team favourites.

Albarino, Coral Do Mar, Rias Baixas, Spain

£35.00

This wine has lovely fresh flavours of orange zest and peach, with hints of saline. It has a beautiful rich mouth feel. A classic spicy Albarino, enjoy with seafood or fish dishes. Once described as a Sauvignon Blanc that's "not trying too hard."

Viognier Swartland 'Limited Release' Swartland, South Africa

£37.00

A fresh and aromatic viognier with rich flavours of peach, apple, vanilla and a slight touch of black pepper spice making this a fantastic wine to complement the chargrilled flavours of any chicken and fish dishes from our fire pit. It is also big enough to pair well with any dishes containing cream or curry flavours. At 14% its big, bold and best enjoyed with food.

Bacchus, Flint Vineyard, Earsham, Norfolk

£38.00

This is a lovely alternative to a New Zealand Sauvignon, but the gooseberry is a little more refined. Its bright, fresh, with aromas of elderflower. It's crisp but not too acidic and has a lovely balance of sweetness. It's great with seafood and even recommended with fish & chips, for the adventurous patron. In our opinion its Flint Vineyards' best vintage on their Bacchus.

Sauvignon Blanc, The Nest, Marlborough, New Zealand

£6.70 £10.00 £13.30 £38.00

A clear, bright wine with lifted aromas of exotic fruits and blackcurrant leaf. The vibrant palate is deliciously crisp, juicy and textured, layered with mineral notes through to a refreshing, zesty finish. A recognised gooseberry palate, as you would expect, however this is far more refined than some of intense 'slap round the face' New Zealand' sauvignons and offers far more balance.

Trebbiano, Chardonnay, 'Moma' Emilia Romagna, Umberto Cesari, Italy

£38.50

Trebbiano is one of the most planted grape varieties in the world also known as Ugni Blanc, when blended with chardonnay it makes this Italian wine a unique, graceful and beautifully balanced wine. It has appealing notes of pear are complimented by crisp fruitiness. 'Moma' wines are exceptional quality, and it was difficult not to list them all, we were restrained and listed our favourite red and white wine, turn the page to check out the wonderful Sangiovese which is amazing if you are returning to eat pizza in the courtyard from our wood fuelled oven.

Wine

Zibibbo DOC Sicilia, Tenute Orestyadi, Sicily, Italy**£39.50**

This grape is a hidden gem and perhaps not top of your wine radar but certainly worth trying. Exceptionally floral Sicilian white, flavoured with yellow melon and peach, the nose a dizzying combination of white flowers and Sicilian lemon. The ideal accompaniment for cheese, fish, grilled seafoods. The vines are grown in relatively deep white soil up to 500 meters altitude. All harvesting is done by hand throughout August and September.

Chardonnay, Avalon, California**£7.00 £10.50 £13.50 £42.00**

On the nose, intense aromas of nectarine, ripe pear, and jasmine. On the palate, freshly baked apple, peach cobbler, with a beautiful touch of oak on a nice subtle finish. This wine is perfect for the change of season, it longs for good company and a creamy seafood dish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Saint Clair, Marlborough, New Zealand**£43.00**

Saint Clair has a worldwide reputation for top quality wines. A concentrated, punchy Sauvignon Blanc with intense guava and lemon fruit with creamy viscosity and freshness. A classic but classy wine with good weight and a lingering finish – If you love Cloudy Bay, you will love this sauvignon.

Chardonnay, Macon-Villages, Olivier Ravier, Burgundy, France**£44.00**

Olivier Ravier is one of the most iconic winemakers in Beaujolais, now trying his hand at a Macon and what an amazing result. This wine is deep golden in colour with delicious notes of white fruits and citrus. Textured on the palate with an appealing roundness and a refreshing lift to the finish. These wines are becoming more limited in availability which is resulting price increases. We have tasted a lot of Macon's and we are super happy with this great wine offering exceptional value for the juice.

Sancerre, Domaine Noel et Jean-Luc Rimbault, Loire, France**£45.00**

This refreshing wine has a lovely balance of acidity and purity of fruit, with citrus and stone fruits complemented by a touch of minerality. The grapes are pulled from gnarled vines that sit on the upper reaches of the Sury vineyard slopes; it is a jewel of Sancerre that delivers pure Sauvignon Blanc.

Chardonnay, 'R Collection', Raymond vineyards, Napa Valley, California**£47.00**

Lucious aromas of pear, pineapple, and tropical fruit which is followed with vanilla and honeysuckle. This Chardonnay has beautiful minerality, tangy citrus and an exquisitely balanced palate, super smooth with just a touch of toasted oak. This is a food wine and amazing with the lobster pie as it stands up to the cream and butter sauce. Its also great with charred chicken and even cheese dishes.

Pouilly-Fuisse, Nadine Ferrand, Burgundy France**£59.00**

Our Executive Head Chef said he would drink this all day long, it's superb! An elegant Pouilly-Fuisse, straw coloured, showing aromas of peach, and citrus. A rich, complex, and well-balanced wine with remarkable vivacity on the finish. This chardonnay is truly outstanding.

ROSÉ WINE

Primitivo Sparkling Rose, Extra Dry, San Marzano Liboll, Puglia, Italy**£9.00 £35.00**

A refreshing and crisp sparkling Rose, with a pale salmon hue, fine bubbles and aromatic notes of orange blossom, pink grapefruit and pomegranate.

Provence Cotes Du Provence, Chateaud de l'aumerade, Cuvee Marie, France**£6.40 £9.50 £12.80 £38.00**

Elegantly styled, with aromas of ripe alpine strawberries, peach and a hint of vanilla. A classic Provence, super pale in colour, dry but with delicious fruits. This is a super example of a Provence Rose and we had the pleasure of trying a lot and this was our winner.

Sancerre Rose, Domaine Serge Laloue, Loire, France**£49.00**

A deliciously silky and balanced Rose offering wild strawberry and kiwi, layered with notes of watermelon and grapefruit. A fresh wine with a lovely purity of fruit. Refined, dry and elegant. This is for tasting not just drinking to appreciate this wonderful example of a classic rose from Loire.

Charmat Rosé, Flint Vineyards, Norfolk, England**£50.00**

Local, multi, award-winning sparkling wine. The wine has a fine mousse and aromas of forest fruits and cherry blossom, the palate that bursts of juicy cassis and wild raspberry. Naturally zippy acidity makes this the perfect aperitif. We have visited the vineyard and have supported this sparkling for years now and it still never lets us down and we think that's the passion and commitment of the Flint team.

RED WINE

125ml 175ml 250ml Bottle

Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah, Carignan, and Cinsault, Jaspe Rouge, Chateau Oumslyat, Lebanon**£29.00**

Lebanon is renowned for Chateau Musar but we wanted to introduce you to this very affordable and quaffable red. Intense and aromatic aromas of wild red and black fruits are overlaid with hints of black pepper.

Merlot, Santiago, Central Valley, Chile**£5.00 £7.25 £9.90 £29.00**

Plummy, fruit notes with subtle cherry and spice flavours combine to provide a wine that's wonderfully smooth and is a great match for our wood fuelled pizza in the summer. This is also quite delicious slightly chilled on a hot day!

Pinot Noir, Umbrella, Romania**£5.20 £7.75 £10.30 £29.00**

Light with soft spicy red fruit flavours and smooth tannins. A lush Romanian speciality which is lovely with white meats too. Full of flavour for a light wine this just as good with white meats and meaty dishes.

Primitivo San Marzano Il Pumo, Salemto, Puglia, Italy**£5.20 £7.75 £10.30 £29.00**

Intense aromas of cooked plus and cherries, full of fleshy and ripe fruit flavours through to a savoury finish with cinnamon notes. This is a moreish unoaked wine from Apulia signature grape it is in fact identical to the Californian zinfandel. The fruit on this wine makes it very easy to drink.

Grenache Noir, Big Buzz, Caves Fonjoja, Languedoc-Roussillon, France**£5.50 £8.00 £10.50 £32.00**

A smooth and fruity red wine with elegant notes of raspberry and blueberry layered with floral hints and delicate notes of menthol. Fresh and juicy with wild red fruits, blueberry and a touch of thyme.

Rioja Crianza, Finca Besaya, Spain**£5.75 £8.50 £10.50 £33.00**

Hailing from Spain's oldest wine region, this 100% Tempranillo Rioja sees only 12 months in oak to add delicate flavours like chocolate and espresso, as well as to retain it's jammy fruit flavours of blackberry and blueberry.

Barbera, Appassimento, San Silvestro, Piedmont, Italy**£36.00**

This price! Offers an outstanding price for a Baby Amarone. Its elegant and silky with ripe blueberries and cherry jam flavours complimented by toasty notes. 91 points international wine challenge we are not alone on our opinion that this is amazing value and truly delicious. We would offer by the glass, however we know that with its quaffable qualities a bottle is the answer!

Don David Malbec, Salta, Argentina**£6.25 £9.50 £12.50 £37.00**

An Argentinian Malbec packed full of blueberry and blackcurrant it is rich, with plum jam, fine perfume of redcurrants, with the elegant scent of violets on the nose. The sweetness of vanilla and a smear of dark chocolate means this is the wine to enjoy with dishes prepared over the coals in our kitchen. We tasted 12 malbecs for our Summer wine list and Don David was a keeper.

Shiraz, Heilan Co, Australia**£6.50 £9.75 £12.50 £39.00**

This producer originally hailed from Scotland, the Heilan Co (Highland Cow) it is robust and fruit forward on the nose. On the palate it is silky, jammy, with plush dark fruits. A wonderfully balanced wine with just enough tannins for a burger or steak but fruit driven enough to be enjoyed by itself.

Montepulciano, Nero d'Avlo, Wild & Wilder, Cloud Cuckooland, Riverland, Australia**£39.50**

This wine is so versatile. It could be served chilled to complement a summers evening or served at room temperature with dinner. Dark plum & cherry flavours with an almost cocoa mouthfeel. For Summer its great with tomato dishes like pizza or lovely with cheese and charcuterie meats sitting in the courtyard.

Faithful Hound Cabernet Franc, Stellenbosch, South Africa**£39.50**

This needs food as it's a big wine. A great blend of grapes makes this truly soft and elegant. Brooding earthy aromas, brambly fruit and hints of cocoa, cinnamon and bay leaf. The palate unfolds with a core of dense fruit, chocolate and vanilla textured tannins and a beautiful finish.

Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, Umbreto Cesare, Moma Emilia Romagna, Italy**£41.00**

Here it is one of the team favourites on this list! Intense aromas of purple plums from the Sangiovese, combined with softness and elegance from late harvest Cabernet Sauvignon which creates a super smooth wine. Smokey aromas with lots of blackcurrant on the nose there are also hints of chocolate and rich vanilla making this a very soft and easy style.

Pinot Noir, Vinum Radford Dale, Barossa Valley, Stellenbosch, South Africa**£41.00**

A real beauty! Dark ruby in colour with aromas of ripe, warm strawberries, Damson and subtle cardamon notes are also typical of this style. South African Pinot Noirs are renowned for great texture and tannins and this one by Ben Radford and Alex Dale delivers this. Drink at room temperature but on a hot day this wine is more than happy to be chilled.

Fleurie, Beaujolais, Burgundy, France**£41.00**

Contrasting the typical style of a classic Beaujolais, this Fleurie stands out against the crowd. A gorgeous full wine hailing in at 14.5% ABV to ensure a good time. Filled with aromas of blueberries and fresh earth, the palate takes a sharp turn. Cranberry, raspberry, and thyme flush the finish.

Chateau Pont de Gitres, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France**£43.00**

Garnet in colour this wine offers a wonderful aromatic nose full of vibrant red and black fruity notes, underpinned by a hint of spice. Silky and beautifully balanced on the palate with concentrated fruit flavours leading to a long, appealing finish.

Ludovico Rosse, Tenute Orestyadi, Sicily, Italy**£43.00**

Full and fruity Sicilian red, spilling over with prunes, mulberry and black cherry, the dark fruit complementing spicy aromas of liquorice, tobacco and pepper. The vineyard is characterised by high sunlight exposure and warm summers which provide the strong flavours in the wine, as well as clay-limestone soils. All harvesting is done by hand throughout September.

Wine

Gran Reserva Rioja, Bodegas Olarra, Cerro Anon, Spain**£45.00**

A gorgeous Gran Rioja true to its style. Soft fruits of black cherry and blueberry, along with fresh pipe-tobacco deliver this gorgeous warm and inviting bouquet. Delicate tannins partner with non-threatening blueberry bushes and a wonderfully oaked herbal thyme finish. Quite possibly the most refined and well-balanced wine our list.

Zinfandel, Bogle, California, USA**£46.00**

A personal favourite of the GM. This wine's nose is filled with damp damson, muted blackberries, and charred oak. The palate is equipped with explosive flavours of intense juicy plum, ripe blueberries, and a long-burnt toffee and cedar finish. When you're hunkering down for the winter, make sure you're stocked up on this wine. Definitely one to share amongst good company.

Malbec, Susana Balbo Mendoza, Argentina**£47.00**

Female wine maker Susana Balbao is Argentina's first female oenologist and owner of her own eponymous winery. Elegance and power in a glass. Intensely coloured with great concentration of flavour which has been created mainly by two cabernets (Sauvignon and Franc). Its smooth and delicious. Girl power!

Grenache, Syrah Famille Perrin's Vacqueyras, Southern Rhone Valley, France**£49.50**

Famille Perrin's Vacqueyras is a beautiful example of Grenache based wines from the Southern Rhône Valley, with an impressive aromatic expression, structured body and great ageing potential. Produced on a very clayey terroir with stones from the Ouvèze river, the Grenache is dominant and develops a fleshy wine. It's typical aromas of chocolate, cherry and fig match beautifully with the Syrah (violet, spice, liquorice)..

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Southern Rhône, France**£49.00**

A stunning example of what this well-known region does so well – red fruits, cranberries, lavender, thyme, and rosemary on the nose. Elegant and silky with ripe tannins with cassis and herb character to finish. Jammy black fruits. Lushly rich and powerful. The perfect Sunday lunch wine.

Greanche, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah Priorat +7 Bodegas Pinord, Spain**£52.50**

Our Bars Manager and Sommelier, Tyler, states if he could drink one wine for the rest of his days this would be the one! A big statement just like this wine. Crianza red wine from Priorat. Aged for 14 months in oak and 12 months in the bottle. Certified organic it has intense notes of black fruit and spices. It has first class acidity, bold tannins, and a nice freshness. A deep garnet colour with an almost bluish undertone. It's a super wine to enjoy with food, although Tyler may possibly be happy to drink without!

Amarone della Valpolicella, Cantina Di Negrar, Veneto, Italy**£52.00**

Grapes dried with the classic Appassimento technique, this wine is deep and intense in colour with black cherries and plums on the nose. The rich velvety tannins accompanied with subtle flavours of raisin and spice structure the backbone of this Amarone. It's truly an indulgent wine.

DESSERT WINE50ml *Bottle***Black muscat, Elysium, California****£5.00 £35.00**

This black muscat is moreish, Elysium being Greek for heaven, a fitting association especially with chocolate desserts. This is amazing poured over ice cream too. Intense and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit.

The wine shows a lovely pale golden color with deep golden highlights. Round and well-balanced offering complex aromas of candied fruits backed up by a hint of exotic fruit (mango, guava) and white flowers. On the palate, it is ample and fleshy, leading into a silky and long finish.
